This meets on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of every month on this frequency for the purposes of training and sharing of information. This is a directed net and all traffic will flow through net control. Please do not break the net unless you have emergency or priority traffic.

Your net control station for this session is **[call sign]**, my name is **[name]**, and I am located in **[city/town]**, Ohio.

In case I am unable to communicate, is there an alternate net control station on frequency? **[Await response]** Thank you, **[name]**; you are the alternate net control station. I have you checked into the net. Please be sure to record all traffic and check-ins during the net.

District 10 consists of Ashtabula, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, and Portage Counties with approximately 250 registered volunteers. For more information about Tenth District, visit [www.ohioares10.org](http://www.ohioares10.org).

This is not a traffic net. However, we will always take formal written NTS messages. Are there any stations with traffic and with traffic only?

Let's start taking check-ins. When called, please give your name, call sign, location, and indicate if you are an ARES member and if you have any traffic for the net.

Now calling: **[call one at a time]**

- Weak or low powered stations, weak or low powered stations only please.
- Mobile stations, mobile stations only please.
- ARES Leaders, ARES Leaders from anywhere, call now.
- Are there any ARRL Ohio Section Cabinet members on frequency, if so, call now?
- Are there any Served Agency Liaisons that would like to check in? Call now.
- General Check-ins, anybody anywhere, call now.

I will now call upon the District Emergency Coordinator Matt W8DEC for any announcements and upcoming events. **[Await response.]**

I will now call upon the Training Officer or DEC for this month's training. **[Await response.]**

**(Check for any additional check-ins)**

At this time are there any stations with announcements, bulletins, or queries?

**(Check for any additional check-ins)** Last call for check-ins.

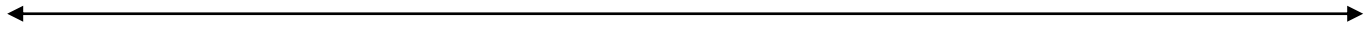

## **Net Report**

The net report consists of the following:

- Day of the month expressed with the number followed by the letters depending on the day. Examples: 31<sup>ST</sup>, 23<sup>RD</sup>, 14<sup>TH</sup>
- Number of check-ins including the NCS.
- Number of messages passed. If none, spell out ZERO.
- Length in minutes, not counting comment round, if applicable.
- Call Sign of traffic liaison. This includes to TCTTN, BRTN, and/or OSSBN. This is not Served Agency Liaisons.
- Call Sign list of check-ins. Examples: W8DEC, KB8JTZ, KD8FTS, etc.

There are two ways to send your net report.

Primary – amateur radio in NTS format.
